

Unlocking the Door to the Power Acts 1 & 2

1. The <u>Promise</u> of Power (End of Luke 24, Acts 1:8)

Jesus doesn't send them out with no <u>hope</u> and no <u>resources</u>, He sends them out with the resource, the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.

Acts 1:8 explains that the power of the church comes from the <u>Holy Spirit</u> and not from <u>man</u>.

2. The Prelude to Power (Acts 1:12-14)

The first key to Power is **Oneness**.

The second Key is **Prayer**.

Acts 1:14- They all joined together **constantly** in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

Prayer is both the <u>thermometer</u> and the <u>thermostat</u> of the local church; for the "<u>spiritual temperature</u>" either goes up or down, depending on how God's people pray.

3. The Proof of Power (Acts 2:1-4 Pentecost)

Because the church had the power of the Holy Spirit to energize its ministry. They were people who "were ignited by the Spirit of God."

When the Spirit fell, it brought about two big changes, the Spirit would <u>dwell in people</u> and not just come on them, and His presence <u>would be permanent</u>, not <u>temporary</u>.



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
