



## Unlocking the Door to the Power

### Acts 1 & 2

#### 1. The Promise of Power (End of Luke 24, Acts 1:8)

Jesus doesn't send them out with no hope and no resources, He sends them out with the resource, the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:8 explains that the power of the church comes from the Holy Spirit and not from man.

#### 2. The Prelude to Power (Acts 1:12-14)

The first key to Power is Oneness.

The second Key is Prayer.

**Acts 1:14-** They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

Prayer is both the thermometer and the thermostat of the local church; for the "spiritual temperature" either goes up or down, depending on how God's people pray.

#### 3. The Proof of Power (Acts 2:1-4 Pentecost)

Because the church had the power of the Holy Spirit to energize its ministry. They were people who "were ignited by the Spirit of God."

When the Spirit fell, it brought about two big changes, the Spirit would dwell in people and not just come on them, and His presence would be permanent, not temporary.



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
